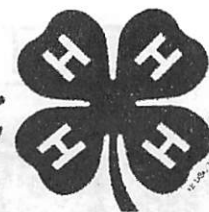




4-H Poster Art Contest

GUIDELINES:

- 1.) The topic for the poster needs to be related to 4-H.
- 2.) The poster design must be original in design and layout. Copies from previous year winning posters will be disqualified.
- 3.) Posters must be 14 x 22 inches.
- 4.) Posters must have a horizontal layout.
- 5.) Name, Teacher, School, grade of the 4-H member, and 4-H leader's name should be clearly written on the back of each poster.
- 6.) Well known cartoon figures cannot be used because they are copyrighted - such as Marvel Super Heroes, Disney characters, Ninja Turtles, Professional athletes, team logos, etc.
- 7.) Three dimensional objects or materials which extend 1/8 inch or more above the surface of the poster may not be used.
- 8.) When using the 4-H Emblem on the poster
 - a. **Do not** place text or other images **over or on top** of the 4-H Emblem.
 - b. The **official colors** should **not be altered**.
 - c. The **clover stem** should turn to the **right** only and the clover should **not be slanted**.

- 9.) Posters that do not follow these guidelines will not be considered for State.

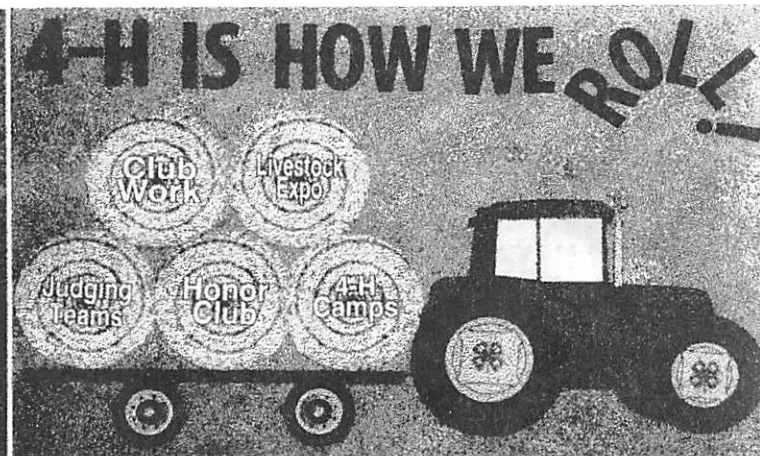
COUNTY AWARDS:

- 2.) The posters placed 11th – 20th receive a blue ribbon.
- 3.) All other state entries receive a red ribbon.
