



The Tennessee Master Row Crop Producer Program is a new educational program designed to further improve the profitability and sustainability of today's row crop farming operations. From fundamental to cutting edge research-based information, training module topics will be delivered through traditional face-to-face meetings as well as an option to complete some credit hours virtually through a series of online videos and quizzes.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Tennessee Master Row Crop certification provides eligibility for the Tennessee Agricultural Enhancement Row Crop Solutions Program at the 50% cost share level. To allow for broad knowledge in row crop production, the Master Row Crop certification requires the following credit hours per topic area to be completed within an annual certification cycle every 3 years:
